

DECLARATION OF INFORMED CONSENT FOR THE PROCEDURE OF PERMANENT THREAD LIFT

This statement should be given to the patient before the procedure.

This document is an example of a mutual informed consent declaration made with our expert, Dr Jean-Paul Foumentèze, as part of the Infinite-Thread® procedure. This document is provided by Thread & Lift for your information only. The practitioner remains solely responsible for the content of the document that he will provide to his patient.

I, the undersigned

certify **to give my consent** to Dr to perform the laying of permanent suspension threads with cogs in the face, the neck and eyebrows under anaesthesia.

I claim to have understood the technique used by Dr

This technique works by ascending the skin of the face, neck and eyebrows, if these areas have been chosen for treatment, as well as subcutaneous tissues through the cogs on the implanted threads. The latter are implanted using semi-blunt needles. The cogs are bidirectional on one half compared to the other. The threads are inserted from an entry point located at the temple and/or mastoid level. We will find one or more threads under each cheek as well as one or more threads on each side of the neck and one in each eyebrow if these areas have been selected for treatment. To allow this technique, the doctor will make a simple puncture or possibly a small incision in the scalp to facilitate the implantation of the thread(s).

I confirm that I have been informed of the expected benefits of this intervention and the therapeutic alternatives

I attest to having received a perfectly clear explanation of the thread I will receive. This is the permanent suspension thread with cogs named "Infinite-Thread®", CE marked according to the Directive 93/42/EEC on medical devices. This thread is made in France by the Thread & Lift laboratory, which is also ISO 13485: 2016 certified. This thread is only composed of bio-materials (solid silicone and polyester).

I acknowledge having been able to ask all the questions concerning this intervention and to have taken note of the risks inherent to any aesthetic or surgical intervention and, in particular, those related to this intervention:

- ecchymosis
- temporary oedemas and irregularities of the skin
- infection
- temporary tension or pain along the threads
- temporary discomfort of facial movements

I certify that the practitioner has answered all my questions, informed me and documented the intervention, will respect a period of legal reflection of 2 weeks before the intervention, and that I have understood the course and the risks of this act for aesthetic purposes.
