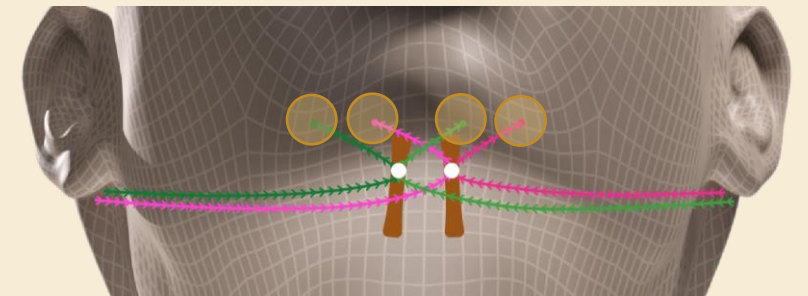
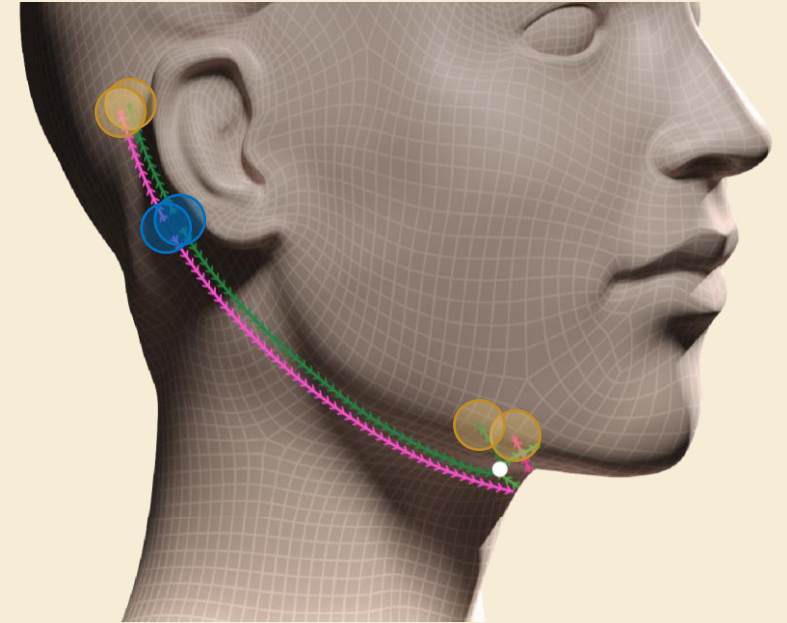


THE “DOUBLE CROSSING” TECHNIQUE - NECK

1. **Double crossing** – of the threads at the level of the platysmal cords (one crossing per platysmal cord).
2. **Pushing in the platysmal cords** – rather than trying to stretch them laterally.
3. **Slight tension** – is sufficient to define the mandibular contours and restore the cervicomental angle.
4. **Deep implantation** – into the platysma beyond the jugular vein.
